



Teachers of Tomorrow

MOS is thrilled to organise Teachers of Tomorrow (TOT) zonal rounds

Teachers of Tomorrow is an interesting intercollegiate team event competition between postgraduates. TOT is an opportunity for PGs to showcase their teaching abilities. Each PG institute team will have 2 post graduates along with 1 PG teacher (from same institute) as mentor. Each PG in the team gets 4 min to present on topic given by committee 2 weeks in advance.

Total marks for each presentation = 10

Divided as:

1. Contents (quality of presentation, technology used, scientific Contents, innovative ways of teaching) : carries 4 marks
2. Speaking/ communication skills, body language, confidence: carries 4 marks
3. Time: 1 mark (0 or 1)
4. Jury question: 1 mark

Marks will be added for both PG of the team, then total marks of the team will be calculated.

Awards:

Best team and best presenter (1st to 3rd each)

* First, we will have zonal elimination rounds in each of 5 zones - to select best team in Each zone

*Selected best teams from each of 5 zones will compete for MOS state TOT award during special dedicated session on TOT in MOSCON 2023. Best TOT state team will be chosen by Jury. There are attractive prizes to be won. Winning team will represent MOS at national TOT competition which will be conducted by AIOS in annual conference at Kolkata.

More than 1 team can be nominated by each medical college/ PG institute

2nd and 3rd year students can participate

Preliminary rounds will be held in first or second week on August in online format.

Topics for presentation will be given by MOS 2 weeks prior to scheduled date of presentation
