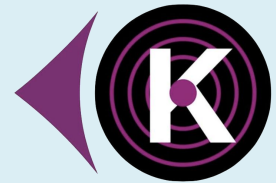

The information that LASIK is a reliable procedure to get rid of “Glass Power” has permeated the common society. However, there are many clinical scenarios in which a LASIK procedure has to be denied. A lack of awareness about the alternative methods or the reluctance to go ahead with them citing lack of know-how & skill leads to disappointment & frustration. This IC collates & presents the alternative correction options. It focuses on PRK & Advance Surface Ablations & highlights their comparative outcomes & relative safety. The talk on ICLs will focus on selection criteria, techniques of the STAAR ICL & outcomes of low cost variants of the same. Another talk will deal with refractive options for patients who have a demonstrable cataract & will focus on the Trifocal and EDOF IOLs. One talk will explain Contact Lenses and Orthokeratology lenses in a concise manner. Lastly, the options in patients who were detected to have corneal ectasia, in the Pre-LASIK work up, will be covered too.
